

## **Council Highlights from February 2025**


MOTION to accept the minutes from January 2025 was carried. Old Business: Online church directory has been tested. Council decided to go forward with this. Announcements will be made. Cost is approximately \$220 per yr. **FINANCE** Through January, donations are \$12,358 above spending, which includes Fellowship balance of \$2266, \$2745 below last year. Through January, envelope offerings are \$6215 below last year, plate offerings are up \$245 and mortgage offerings are up \$2669. Total income is down \$3145 compared to last year which is a 5.9% decrease. Through January, our expenses are \$4831 below our 2025 spending plan but above last year by \$4652 (11.3% increase). Required approval of Audit committee was made. MOTION: A motion to approve the Audit Committee (Jo Duhn, chair; Dick Williams and Mickie Gabl assisting) passed. MOTION: A motion was made for Shawn Hernandez to be the designated official to sign distribution documents and W-9 on behalf of HTLC for the Doris M. Mayer Trust. Motion passed. PROPERTY Fans have been installed in Sanctuary and Fellowship which has allowed temperatures to be increased from 72° to 76° which will save on electric bills. Temperature may need to be adjusted. A high water usage message was received by the church. Plumber has been there to investigate leak. A quote has been received for AC maintenance on our 26 AC units. Quote was only a couple of hundred more than what we currently have but for more maintenance work. **MOTION:** A motion to accept the AC bid was passed. A quote was received for professional cleaning and sealing of grout lines for kitchen floor. We will ask for a quote from our current cleaning service. Tabled to next meeting. MUTUAL MINISTRY: No meeting PASTORS' TIME: Guest speaker, Jacqueline Matthews Williams from Lutheran Services of Fl (LSF) talked about the loss of funding (approx. 90%). She reviewed what a refugee was and all the paperwork needed to be vetted for the USA. Funding is no longer available through usual sources (Global Refugee Services, etc.) to house these refugees. YOUR INPUT AND THOUGHTS Good turnout for Jesus Loves You Ministry walk. Over \$32,000 was raised by all participants. NEW BUSINESS: MOTION: A motion to disburse the Mission Endowment funds (MEF) as recommended by the MEF committee was passed (see office for the specifics). We have approximately \$45,000 in surplus funds from last year (income over expenses). **MOTION:** A motion to help support three LSF refugee families for a 3-month period including rent/utilities for \$5748 per month for a total of \$17,244 to be paid out of the surplus, was passed. MOTION: A motion to follow the recommendation of the Finance Committee and give both Miles and Cecil a special gift of appreciation for all they do, was passed. CORRESPONDENCES Thank you notes from Crossroads for a blanket received. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS:** Our Sunday school teachers. Next meeting 3/19/2025.





# A Call for Help - Supporting Refugee Families





My name is Jorja Knollenberg, and I had the blessing of being Confirmed at Holy Trinity this past October. As part of my Confirmation journey, I have been looking for the right opportunity to serve others. Recently, a need was brought to my attention, and I feel called to help.

Lutheran Services of Florida (LSF) is currently supporting 11 refugee families who have come to the U.S. legally after years of paperwork and waiting. LSF has been assisting them with housing and utilities until they can become self-sufficient. However, due to a sudden loss of

funding, these families are now at risk of losing their homes.

Our church has already stepped in to help three families for the next three months, but seven more families still need support. Some of them include children facing serious health challenges like eye cancer and cerebral palsy.

On **Sunday, March 9th**, I will have a table set up between services with sweet treats and a donation basket. If you feel moved to give, any amount will make a difference. If you're unable to give financially, I ask that you keep these families and the work of LSF in your prayers.

Thank you for considering this need. I am grateful for our church community and the kindness you continually show to those in need.
